- Prepare packages for military and emergency personnel in our community (this project comes onsite to your office)

Business Volunteer Connect will customize and manage a project for up to 15 employee volunteers (additional volunteers can be accommodated for an additional fee). Sponsorship of a project also includes lunch, publicity and the sponsor's logo on business volunteer connect.org.
