From 2008-2011, Mr. Gottlieb was Global Editions editor of the *New York Times*, overseeing the editorial operations of the *International Herald Tribune*, with newsrooms in Paris and Hong Kong. Prior to that, he held several other positions at the *Times*: associate managing editor, deputy culture editor, national project editor and Metropolitan desk and investigative reporter. Gottlieb also served as managing editor at the *Daily News* (New York) and editor-in-chief at the *Village Voice*. He began his career as a reporter at *The Record* in 1971.

Gottlieb attended Queens College and the Columbia University Graduate School of Journalism. He received a Loeb Fellowship from the Harvard University Graduate School of Design in 1979. He has taught journalism at the Columbia University Graduate School of Journalism and at NYU. In 2008, Gottlieb was the James H. Ottoway Professor of Journalism at SUNY New Paltz and, in 2009, he was a visiting Ferris Professor of Journalism at the Princeton University Council of Humanities .
